

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Mr. Ali Bin Hassan Al-Muraikhi Appointed as Director and Acting General Manager of Qatar Steel

H.E. Yousef Hussain Kamal, Minister of Economy & Finance and Chairman of Qatar Steel has ratified the appointment of Mr. Ali Bin Hassan Al-Muraikhi as the Acting General Manager of Qatar Steel with effect from 4 November 2010.

Mr. Al-Muraikhi was a Director of Q-Coat as well as the Commercial Division Manager of Qatar Steel.

It also observed that meetings of this nature should be held on a regular basis in order to discuss the latest developments and trends and to find immediate solutions for any issues.

Mr. Mohammed Ahmed Al Saadi, Marketing Manager of Qatar Steel delivered a short presentation on the outlook of the global steel industry in general, and the average rebar and coil consumption in the domestic

market in particular. This was followed by a question and answer session.

Mr.Al-Muraikhi, the Director and Acting General Manager raised several important topics for discussion, including the need to have a better understanding of the prevailing market conditions in order to formulate a suitable strategic plan that will ensure stability and uniformity of rebar retail prices for all Qatar Steel distributors. This will, in turn, facilitate the continued and improved demand for steel in general in the domestic market. He also stressed upon the importance of transparency and co-operation by providing the Company with regular information about the domestic market, especially regarding the import of steel materials.

In his vote of thanks, Mr. Ali Bin Hassan Al-Muraikhi, Director and Acting General Manager of Qatar Steel, thanked the valued customers for attending the meeting and wished them a prosperous future ahead.

The 77 million tons of annual gas production, awarding of the organising rights for the 2022 FIFA World Cup, the new legislations for improving the investment climate, earmarking US\$140 million in the coming 10 years for the already strong infrastructure, the new Doha seaport, the new Doha airport, tourism, enlarging the electricity and water distribution network, health projects, the high growth rate of the economy during the past years despite the international economic crisis (22.9% average annual growth rate of GNP during 2005-2009), the high per capita (one of the highest in the world), diversification of economy by encouraging large, small and medium private sector projects in the first strategic plan 2011-2016 within Qatar Vision 2030 and the preparedness of the Government for further expenditure will have a strong positive impact on the economy of Qatar and the region and will increase the competitiveness of Qatar with regard to attracting regional and international investments.

Qatar Steel appraised the visitors and participants of the conference on the importance of Qatar Steel and the role it is playing in the State of Qatar and in the neighbouring countries towards accelerating development.





Qatar Steel Participates in World Steel Association Conference

Health, safety and environment representatives from major steel companies all over the world gathered at Ashorne Hill Management College in London from the 6th to 9th of September to attend the World Steel Association's HSE conference. This event was hosted by Corus Group and was chaired by Mr. Jefferey Diedorf, General Manager for Safety and Health Hygiene of the United States Steel Corporation. A total of 37 delegates representing 26 major steel companies attended this conference.

Various presentations on health, safety and environment were delivered and open discussions were encouraged to facilitate knowledge-sharing especially with regard to lessons learnt and best practices in the industry. Open discussions about current practices and trends on Behaviour Based Safety in world steel companies were held to facilitate the companies' journey to ZERO accidents and world-class safety performance.

Qatar Steel was represented by Mr. Yousef R. Al-Suwaidi, Head of Health, Safety and Environment. His presentation was well received and the participating companies appreciated Qatar Steel's exemplary safety performance which features low rates on lost time incidents, FR, SR and Fatality Rates (FFR). These rates are known to be among the best in the steel industry. The other participating companies also presented their lost time incidents and fatality accidents along with the good practices in use with the aim of educating various steel companies on the seriousness of accidents and the importance of having proper policies and precautions in place to prevent them.

The 2009 Metrics Survey Report was also presented. The survey covered 70 steel companies and 1,224 metric tons of crude steel production with a FFR of 0.026 for employees, FFR of 0.048 for contractors, LTIFR of 1.62 for employees and LTIFR of 3.09 for contractors. The safety metrics provided by World Steel in combination with the regular participation of steel industry majors in World Steel Conferences will help the participating companies to benchmark their safety results and improve their own performance.

Qatar Steel Participates in Made in Qatar 2011
